

**TWO ENTOMBED
MINERS SAVED**

All but One of the Men Trapped in Mid-Valley Colliery Rescued.

**TWO REACH SURFACE
WITHOUT INJURIES**

One of Miners Fell Down the Chute and Was Killed—Rescuing Party Penetrates Among Fallen Coal and Discovers Men Had Dug a Great Distance Toward the Entrance to the Drift—No Bad Effects of the Experience.

POTTSVILLE, Pa., Feb. 18—All but one of the miners who were entombed yesterday in the Mid-Valley colliery were rescued alive early this morning. One of the miners was killed following the accident which entombed the men and two were injured.

The others appeared none the worse for the accident.

Frank O. Floskie, a miner of Mid-valley, fell down the chute after the accident and was killed. When the rescuing party penetrated to the entombed men it was found that the men had dug for a great distance through fallen coal.

There were but few persons at the entrance to the drift when the rescued men reached the surface. The men quickly made their way to their homes showing no bad effects of their experience.
