

## Miner Buried 8 Hours Saved

Boulder, June 20.—Buried by a slide in a gold mine and extricated after almost eight hours of frantic efforts by fellow-employees and volunteer rescue squads, Bernard Meyring, 60, of Boulder, was recovering at a hospital here today from exposure and minor injuries.

He was removed late last night from a stope on the 80-foot level of the Oregon mine, west of Sugar Loaf. Altho the miner was completely buried, the top of a pile of ore, rocks and debris four feet above his head—a lumber partly protected him and created a fissure thru which he could obtain air and talk to his rescuers.

Meyring suffered cuts, bruises and sprains but apparently no broken bones. Results of X-rays were not available this morning.
