

Entombed Miner Rescued After Accidental Burial

PITTSTON, OCT 28—UP—A Pittston coal miner has been rescued from an abandoned mine shaft after being entombed for several hours. He is 58-year old Benjamin Desko. The coal worker was locked in the shaft when the exit was filled in by a bulldozer operator, who was unaware that Desko was in the shaft.

The miner was reported missing by his wife when he failed to return home. She went to the shaft where her husband said he would be working and discovered the entrance blocked. However, a hurried alarm was sounded and workers of the Pennsylvania Coal Company made the rescue. Desko was found to be done the worst for his experience when he was examined at Pittston Hospital.
