
A Breaker Boy Killed.

Charles McNeil, the fourteen-year-old son of John McNeil, of Tower City, met with an accident at Brookside colliery which resulted in his death. While at work he was caught by a rush of coal and carried into the breaker rollers, and before the machinery could be stopped his right leg was horribly mangled. The boy was at once removed to his home where Drs. Wilson and Phillips attended him, but he died about ten hours after the accident. His remains will be interred to-day.
