
NINE MINERS RESCUED FROM COAL MINE FIRE

DENVER, Colo., Nov. 15.—Fire which broke out tonight in the surface buildings of the Monarch mine, two and a half miles south of Louisville, Colo., destroyed the tipple of the mine and caused damage, the amount of which has not been estimated, according to a report received here.

Nine men who were reported to have been trapped in the mine were said to have been rescued through an air shaft. The cause of the fire has not been discovered. The mine is the property of the National Fuel company.
