

FIRE IN WEST VIRGINIA MINE

**Men in Paint Creek Colliery Rescued
With Difficulty.**

Charleston, W. Va., March 25 —
Within an hour after orders had been issued for the withdrawal of part of the military on duty in the coal country of Kanawha county, where martial law has reigned for almost two months because of the strike of miners, a fan-house of the Scranton mine of the Paint Creek Collieries company was destroyed by fire and forty men at work in the mine were rescued with difficulty.

The fire ate into the workings and at a late hour was burning 300 feet from the mouth of the mine along the main entry.
