

Miner Rescued After 5 Hours

CARBONDALE, Jan. 30.—Pinned by a rock fall, Peter Kobat, 55, Mayfield miner, was rescued shortly after 1.30 p. m. today by diggers who had worked in relays for five hours.

Only slightly hurt, according to a physician, the middle-aged miner was carried from the shaft of the Pitha Coal Company mine and rushed to a hospital.

Doctors, who had administered stimulants to Kobat as he lay imprisoned up to his waist in fallen rock, said the miner would recover.
