175 MINERS ENTOMBED; HOPE IS ABAN

EXPLOSION IN MINE

Expected to Result In Death of
Every Workman

ROCK SPRINGS, Wyo, March 8.—All of the 17 persons entombed in Utah Mine No. 2 at Castle Gate, are doomed, officials of the company said they believed this afternoon.

At 130 p. m. black damp gas was pouring out of the portals in such a deadly stream that rescuers were driven back and were being compelled to remain helplessly outside until more equipment arrived on the scene.

No one could possibly be alive within the mine, was the word coming in messages here.

Without a single survivor to give them hope or a person who can explain the cause of the word and the state is referred to the resuments.
