
Boulder Crushes Woman at Mine

Crushed beneath a heavy boulder, Mrs. Mary E. Elliott was killed this week at the Wide Awake mine in Sierra county. The body was sent yesterday to her home in Santa Paula, Calif., for funeral services and burial.

The accident occurred when a derrick boom snapped and dislodged the boulder, which struck Mrs. Elliott.

The mine, located near Downieville, has been operated during the summer by Mrs. Elliott and her husband, Alfred B. Elliott.
