

Charleroi R. D. 1 Miner Killed

A loosened boulder fell in a work place in the Crescent No. 2 mine of the Republic Steel Corp. about 1:10 a.m. today, fatally injuring Albert Lambert, 47, of Charleroi R. D. 1, a machine operator.

The rock narrowly missed three other men nearby.

Lambert, who lived about five minutes, was pronounced dead of a fractured skull in the mine emergency room by a doctor called from California. County Coroner L. C. Gray will investigate.

Lambert is survived by his wife, Mabel; two sons, four daughters, his parents, four brothers and six sisters.
