

# Coal Miner Electrocuted At Banning

**Andrew V. Bealko,  
Old C'ville Road,  
Accident Victim**

Andrew Victor Bealko, 37, of the Old Connellsville Rd., was electrocuted last night at Banning 3 Mine, Republic Steel Corp.

An assistant foreman at the mine, Mr. Bealko was making an examination of the mine when the accident occurred at 8:15. There were no witnesses to the accident, mine officials said this morning.

Employed at the mine since August 1955, the victim reportedly was in the process of transferring a locomotive around when he came in contact with electric lines.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Veronica Mateosky Bealko; five sons, Robert, Andrew Jr., Bernard, Lawrence and Kevin, all at home; one brother, Joseph, Lorain, Ohio; three sisters, Mrs. Matthew (Helen) Mikula, Uniontown; Mrs. John (Mary) Vrabel and Mrs. Steve (Madelyn) Novak, both of Continental 2, and his mother, Mrs. Mary Bealko, also of Continental 2.

Mr. Bealko was a member of St. Mary's R. C. Church, First Catholic Slovak Union and the Holy Name Society. He was financial secretary of St. Mary's Boosters Club.

Friends will be received in the Haky Funeral Home from 7 o'clock this evening until Wednesday morning at 8:30, followed by Requiem High Mass at St. Mary's R. C. Church. Interment will follow in St. Mary's Cemetery.
