

Injuries Fatal To Mine Fire Boss

Injuries received in a mining accident Monday morning proved fatal to Clarence Harris, 59, of Millsboro.

Harris died at 9:12 a.m. Tuesday in Brownsville General Hospital, with death attributed to internal injuries, shock and a fractured pelvis.

A fire boss at Clyde No. 1 mine of Republic Steel Corporation, Fredericktown, Harris was injured in a collision between a coal loader and a mine car.
