

Iron Miner Killed in Fall Down Ore Chute

LYON MOUNTAIN, (AP) —
A 41-year-old miner plunged 200 feet to his death Monday at a Republic Steel Corp. iron mine at Lyon Mountain, near the Canadian border.

State Police said Olin Cassavaw or nearby Chateaugay fell into an iron ore chute after he had packed a dynamite charge 600 feet below the opening of the mine. It was not determined immediately what caused him to fall.
