
Four Men Trapped in Mine Fire Rescued

MURPHYSBORO, Ill., July 28 (by the Associated Press).—The four men trapped by flames in a shaft of the Midway Coal Company's mine near Ward, ten miles northeast of this city, when they went down to investigate the fire in the shaft, were rescued late tonight by a mine relief team, directed by Frank Rossbottom, State mine inspector of Euquoin, Ill. The last one of the four was taken from the shaft shortly before midnight, about an hour after the other three had been liberated.
