# State of West Virginia Description of Fatal Mine Accidents

## **COAL FATALS**

## **— 2024 —**

### August 5, 2024 – Leer Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage

On August 5, 2024, a miner was struck in the head while using an air lifting bag to rerail a longwall electrical power car. On August 7, 2024, the miner died from his injuries.

## <u>July 12, 2024 – Wyco Surface Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage</u>

A truck driver was seriously injured after being struck by the bucket of a front-end loader. On July 23, 2024, the truck driver died from her injuries.

## May 16, 2024 – Coal Mountain No. 1 – Classification – Machinery

A contractor died after the excavator he was operating fell over a highwall.

## **— 2023 —**

#### August 18 2023 – Twin State Mine No. 39 – Classification – Drowning

A miner was installing hose for a dewatering pump when he was found lying in water and mud on the mine floor. WV Investigation Report

### March 22, 2023 – Longview Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage

A miner died when a battery powered personnel carrier he was riding on overturned. The vehicle drifted backwards, and after striking the coal rib, pinned the victim beneath it. <u>WV Investigation Report</u>

## February 26, 2023 – LMS Excavating – Classification – Machinery

A contractor employee died when the bulldozer he was operating left the haul road and rolled down a hill. The contractor employee was ejected from the bulldozer. WV Investigation Report

## **— 2022 —**

#### <u>September 1, 2022 – Coalburg Tunnel Mine – Classification – Electrical</u>

A miner was electrocuted when he contacted a hook that became energized after it penetrated the 480-volt cable that supplied power to a roof bolting machine. WV Investigation Report

#### August 17, 2022 – Tunnel Ridge Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage

Victim died when he was caught between a supply car and its coupler. The victim was sitting on the supply car which was coupled to a locomotive parked in a track spur. The locomotive was struck by another locomotive pulling three loaded cars into the mine. The impact knocked the victim off the supply car, killing him. WV Investigation Report

#### February 28, 2022 – Berwind Deep Mine – Classification – Machinery

A contract miner was tramming a single boom face drill to the surface when he became pinned between the drill and the coal rib. WV Investigation Report

## January 14, 2022 – Ohio County Mine – Classification – Fall of Person

While replacing a belt conveyor roller inside a preparation plant, a contractor fell approximately 27 feet onto a concrete floor. WV Investigation Report

#### **— 2021 —**

#### January 22, 2021 – Davy Branch Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage

The victim was struck by another shuttle car that was traveling to the feeder. The victim died from complications of his injuries on February 21, 2021. WV Investigation Report

#### June 2, 2021 – Marion County Mine – Classification – Fall of Rib

The victim was fatally injured after being struck by a rib roll and pinned against a roof bolting machine while it was being used to install rib bolts. WV Investigation Report

#### <u>June 3, 2021 – Horse Creek Eagle Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage</u>

The victim was crossing through an intersection and was struck by a shuttle car, resulting in fatal injuries. WV Investigation Report

#### August 4, 2021 – Marfork Coal Company – Classification – Fall of Person

The victim was cleaning a piece of equipment when he fell resulting in fatal injuries. WV Investigation Report

## <u>August 11, 2021 – Carter Roag Coal Co – Classification – Powered Haulage</u>

The victim received fatal crushing injuries while conducting a pre-operational check of the tandem coal truck that he was going to operate. WV Investigation Report

### November 1, 2021 – Mountaineer II Mine – Classification – Powered Haulage

The victim was traveling down the slope travelway on a rubber tire EMU (Electronic Mine Utility Vehicle) when the vehicle crashed, resulting in fatal injuries. WV Investigation Report
