

ALL WERE UNCONSCIOUS

Five Men Rescued From a Mine

(By The Associated Press.)

Latrobe, Pa., Feb. 28.—The Hostetter-Connellsville Coke company mine near here was the scene of a fire damp explosion yesterday, in which it was thought seven men lost their lives.

Their names are Michael Flack, Michael Flack, Jr., a boy; William Hesser; Steve Hodduk, John Gakish, Charles R. Benny and John Penzeria, a boy.

Hopes were entertained that the men might be living and three rescuing parties made efforts to reach them.

Five men were rescued at noon. All were unconscious.
