
LLOYD BROCIIOUS 4TH FATALITY IN EXPLOSION

Punxsutawney, Pa. —Lloyd Brocious, of Punxsutawney, 36-year-old father of three children, died in the Adrian Hospital Tuesday afternoon at 4:15 o'clock, the 4th fatality in the September 5 Anita strip mine blast that sent 12 men to the Adrian Hospital here with grievous burns from flaming gasoline.

Brocious, according to a certificate issued by Fred W. Beyer, of this city, coroner for Jefferson County, died of shock and burns of the face, arms, hands and shoulders, suffered when the gasoline tank on a power shovel exploded 12 days ago on the George Yoxheimer stripping project near Anita.

His death followed by six days the death of Harold Murry, 37, of Anita, the blast's third fatality. Gusta Miller, 39, of Punxsutawney R. D. 1 (Dutchtown), died September 8 and Wade Depp, 30, of Punxsutawney, R. D. 4, died September 7, two days after the disaster.
