
LOST MINER FOUND.

Davies Almost Starved to Death Before He Found His Way Out of Coxey Shaft.

WILKES-BARRE, Pa., Dec. 29.—Joseph Davies, a miner, who become lost in the Coxey shaft of the Lehigh Valley Coal Company, at Pittston, on Dec. 20, was found in the mine early this morning, almost starved to death, having been without food for eight days.

When found he was slightly demented from his experience, and could not give an account of his wanderings, except that he had walked a long way, had nothing to eat, and drank the sulphur water of the mine.

He broke his fast by drinking two quarts of beer and eating a loaf of bread.
