

TWO, SAVED FROM DEATH IN MINE, TO RESUME WORK

SHENANDOAH Pa Nov 21—
(UP)—William Bokuniewicz, 52
father of 11 children and 'not
afraid of anything' said today he
would resume work at the bootleg
coal hole in which he and an ap-
prentice miner were entombed 40
hours before they were rescued
unharmcd Sunday

Bokuniewicz and Joseph Comis-
ky, 18 remained in a hospital de-
spite their protestations that near-
ly two days 30 feet underground
had done them no harm Hospital
attaches said both were in "fine
shape but were being guarded
against pneumonia

Rescue workers dug for two
nights and a day through a mass
of muddy earth and rock which
filled the makeshift bootleg anth-
racite mine shaft where the men
were trapped Friday afternoon

Bokuniewicz said they just sat
there and waited' during the per-
iod of their entombment Comisky
added that he dropped off to sleep
Saturday night and dreamed he
was in a coffin
