
Area Man Saved From Death In Uranium Mine

Andrew Haladay, 32, Bloomsburg, was saved from possible asphyxiation Monday by firemen and an ambulance crew who administered emergency respiration treatment to the man after he was overcome by fumes from a gasoline engine in a uranium mine near Orangeville.

A brother, Frank, heard his calls for help, and found him unconscious. He managed to tie his brother to a ladder, and reach the ground level himself, then flagged a motorist who summoned police and firemen, who brought the unconscious man to the surface.
