Area Man Saved From Death In Uranium Mine

Andrew Haladay, 32, Blooms-burg, was saved from possible asphyxiation Monday by firemen and an ambulance crew who administered emergency respiration treatment to the man after he was overcome by fumes from a gasoline engine in a uranium mine near Orangeville.

A brother, Frank, heard his calls for help, and found him unconscious. He managed to tie his brother to a ladder, and reach the ground level himself, then flagged a motorist who summoned police and firemen, who brought the unconscious man to the surface.
