
Boy Killed in Mine at Savannah.

An unusual accident caused the death of Herbert Ray Harrison, aged 12 years, in the mine of the Union Mining Company at Savannah at an early hour Monday morning. The boy had gone into the mine with his brother, who was cleaning the slope. Returning in a car, the cable coupling slipped off and the car ran 600 feet to the bottom of the stope, which dips over 45 degrees. The car was broken into pieces and the boy killed. His body was badly mangled.
