## DIED WHEN RESCUED

---

### Mine Owner Gibbs Expired When Brought to Surface

Joplin, Mo., April 23.—Thomas Gibbs, the remaining miner of the five entombed yesterday at the M. & B. mine near Duenweg, was rescued this morning, but no sooner had he been brought to the surface than he died.

This brings the casualties to three. Charles Evans, assistant ground boss, and George Bennett, a shoveler, were killed; Albert Winthrop and James R. Jones, shovelers, were severely injured, and Thomas Gibbs, owner of the mine, entombed by the mine cavein at Duenweg, five miles east of Joplin, yesterday afternoon. Covered by debris, Winthrop and Jones fought desperately for their liberty and escaped.
