50 FEET DEEP WEST KENTUCKY HEAT AT STURGES

HEAT WAVE ENDS IN EAST, BREEZE OUT OF BERMUDAS

Oppressed Sections Hail Wind
With Joy, As Mercury
Slows Lower.

WEST AGAIN WRACKED BY SUMMER STORMS

National Toll From Humidity
and Sun-rays Mounts
to New Level.

CHICAGO, June 8.—Relief came to the middle west today from the intense heat which has taken a national toll of 441 lives in the last nine days. Although western temperatures were moderated to some extent yesterday by clouds, rain and wind, resulting in a smaller number of deaths than the day before, the relief area spread today as the atmospheric disturbance from the Rocky Mountains continued eastward. Deaths throughout the country yesterday directly attributed to the heat numbered 137, all but eight in the eastern territory. The previous total for the country was 224 deaths.

By Tuesday the weather men predicted, the cooler weather will have progressed to Tennessee, the Ohio valley and the lower lake region.

The entrance of the storm into the middle west was accompanied by considerable damage in several states. High winds, small tornadoes and rain demolished buildings, flooded lowlands, uprooted trees and caused considerable damage to crops.

Tot High Sunday

Little Falls, Minn., Omaha, Neb., Vin and Ardmore, Okla., Warr, Colo., and Denver, Colo., were in the path of the storm. Near Warr a sale over 25 miles of territory, resulting in more than a hundred deaths and injuries to a score of persons.

New York, East, Believed.

NEW YORK, June 8.—The backbone of a heat wave which lasted from six to eight days in the eastern states was broken early today in practically all sections.

After climbing 110 lives yesterday, 71 in Philadelphia alone, and more than 400 during the spell in the east, the terror was gone away in front of a brisk northeast wind. Beginning on the New England coast, temperatures extended as low as 70 degrees in five hours. The thunders swept over New York shortly before midnight, cutting off the heat.

Fighting started between Yunnan troops controlling Canton, China, and followers of the late Dr. Sun Yat-sen, quartered in the island of Hsiao, when sun and his followers fired on the electric light station.
