Hugh Brown, a breaker boy, engaged in the D. & H. Coal Co's breaker, at Five Points, was instantly killed on Tuesday, by being run over by nine breaker cars. The works had shut down at three o'clock in the afternoon, but Brown in company with a number of his associates loitered about to play. They loosened the brake on the mine cars, and they ran down the incline, striking the unfortunate boy, and killing him instantly. He was 14 years of age.
