Lost Miner Rescued In Illinois Shaft

MARION, Ill., Aug. 11 (INS)—Jesse Wilson, 30-year-old Marion coal mine owner, lost in the depths of an abandoned coal mine shaft since noon Monday, was found early this morning by rescuers and taken to Herrin hospital.

The search for Wilson began late Monday when Wilson did not come out of the mine with other workers at 5 p. m. He had entered the pit, a slope mine, with the announced intention of exploring the workings which are adjacent to abandoned working of a deep shaft mine no longer operating.
