

RESCUER DIES IN MINE

**Foreman Overcome by Gas Seeking
Man Who Had Gone Out.**

Greensburg, Pa., Nov. 16.—While searching for a man, whom he believed had been lost in a mine of the Jamison Coal & Coke company, near here, William Kirkley, a division foreman was overcome by gas and was dead when rescuers found him.

The man had been sent into the mine to make some repairs and when he failed to return, Kirkley went in to locate him.

When Kirkley failed to return a rescue party entered and found the foreman's body in an abandoned working, which had become gaseous. An investigation showed that the man the foreman had attempted to save, left the mine before Kirkley entered.
