

# 4 COAL MINERS DIE IN SLIDE

ROUNDUP, Mont., Jan. 28. (AP)—Four coal miners were killed this afternoon in a reported rock fall at a mine east of Roundup in central Montana.

The accident happened at the Montana Queen Mine of the Mountain States Mining company.

Ed Nicholson, company manager, identified the dead as Martin Meznarich, 54; Frank Nose, 45; Jim Molnar, 48, and George Larson, all of Roundup.

The Montana Queen mine is one of two Roundup mines sharing in a recently reawarded contract to furnish coal for the atomic energy commission's plant at Richland, Wash. The other is the Roundup Mining company's No. 3 mine.

Details about the accident were not immediately available.
