

Woman Killed by Mine Engine

Mrs. Annie Kasmonites, an aged woman, met with fatal injuries Saturday morning when she was struck by the small mine "lokie" at No. 11 shaft, and died shortly afterwards. The deceased was picking coal near the mouth of the tunnel and before the engineer could stop the small engine she was run down. One leg was broken, also her back and her head was badly cut. She was alive when carried to the colliery office, but died before a physician could reach her.

The woman had lived in this section many years. Formerly she resided in the city, but for the past four months had made her home in Inkerman, where she kept boarders. Her husband died many years ago. She leaves two sons, both residing in Hartford, Conn.

The funeral will take place Tuesday morning, with services in St. Casimir's Church, and burial in St. Casimir's Cemetery.
