

**SAVED FROM BURNING MINE**

**Officers and Stockholders Rescued by Heroic Workmen.**

Houghton, Mich., Nov. 1.—Fire broke out in the Central mine this afternoon. The miners ascended to the surface at once. Later it was discovered that Frank Stanton, agent of the mine, with his father, John Stanton, of New York, secretary of the company, and William A. Payne, of Boston, were still in the mine. A relief party descended into the mine and by almost superhuman efforts rescued the imprisoned men, who were well nigh exhausted. The mine openings have all been sealed air tight and the fire will be suffocated.
