**By Being Caught in the Machinery of
the Horton Breaker.**

James Quinn, a son of Patrick Quinn, of Kinneytown, near Plains, and employed in the breaker of the Horton colliery as a slate picker was killed there this morning by being caught between the machinery. The boy was 14 years old and was at work near the belt wheel at the rollers when he became caught between the belt and the wheel. He was removed to his home but was so badly injured that he died before he reached there.
