

Worker Rescued From Mine Shaft

ALTOONA (AP) — A state Game Commission worker was in stable condition this morning after being rescued from the bottom of a 60-foot shaft after an accident while on a bat-counting expedition.

The worker, James Kennedy of Uniontown, was one of about 10 people helping with an annual census of the endangered Indiana bat inside the cave and abandoned mine in Canoe Creek State Park, said Game Commission spokesman Lantz Hoffman.
